

STOPPING SAFELY DURING AN EMERGENCY

Even if you take all the proper safety precautions stopping on the side of the road, especially on the highways and interstates, tragic accidents can occur. Sudden breakdowns or an emergency creates a serious driving hazard. Road shoulders should be used for emergency stopping only. The best choice is to continue to the next exit that has a safe and legal area to park. Far too often, especially at night or when the other motorist is ill, fatigued or otherwise distracted, they may inadvertently follow your vehicle off the roadway not knowing you are stopping on the shoulder.
